This funding will be used to


- Enable in excess of 30% of Year 3 and 5 students to achieve Upper Two Bands(U2B) in all strands of NAPLAN within two years.
- Provide a 5% improvement in 2017 NAPLAN mean score for Reading and Number in Year 3 and Year 5.
- Increase student enrolment in the 2018 Preparatory Year.
- Provide every student with a measurable and targeted Reading and Number facts program.

Our initiatives include

- Building teacher capability through professional development and coaching to deliver a consistent and quality Reading and Number facts program from Prep to Year 6.
- Engaging early intervention for Preparatory and pre-Preparatory students.
- Continuing an extension program for talented learners.
- Improving a targeted program in Reading and Number facts for all students.
- Continuing to market the school to increase student enrolment and resources.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Employing additional teacher aides to support a whole school and intensive targeted year level reading program. | \$100,000 |
| • Employing 0.4 teacher for student programs in the U2B of NAPLAN. | \$45,000 |
| • Resourcing Prep Transition program to ensure a seamless start to school. | \$10,000 |
| • Developing leader and teacher capability by engaging coaches, providing professional development and supporting teachers to deliver quality Reading and Maths programs. | \$80,000 |
| • Enacting marketing strategies to further enhance school profile and enrolment growth. | \$19,200 |
