\$274,520*

This funding will be used to

- Enable in excess of 35% of Years 3 and 5 students to achieve Upper Two Bands (U2B) in all strands of NAPLAN within two years.
- Provide a 5% improvement in 2018 NAPLAN mean score for Spelling and Number in Years 3 and 5.
- Increase student enrolment in the 2019 Preparatory Year.
- Monitor every student's improvement in Literacy and Numeracy.


Our initiatives include

- Building teacher capability through a collaborative coaching program in Literacy and Numeracy from Prep to Year 6.
- Engaging early intervention for Prep-Year 2 and Pre-Preparatory students.
- Progressing towards all classrooms being flexible, engaging environments that meet learner needs.
- Improving a targeted intervention program in Reading, Spelling and Numeracy for all students.
- Continuing to market the school to increase student enrolment and resources.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Employing additional teacher aides to support a whole school and intensive targeted literacy program for Prep to Year 2 | \$80,000 |
| • Purchase 70 iPads, 70 laptops and lockable cabinets to share across double class learning spaces | \$77,100 |
| • Developing leader and teacher capability by engaging coaches, providing professional development and supporting teachers to deliver quality Spelling and Mathematics programs. | \$80,000 |
| • Enacting marketing strategies to further enhance school profile and enrolment growth | \$37 420 |
